Message from Leadership

ROI's focus is to help improve the quality of life for people with disabilities and their families, and this past year we have done that for 592 people, many of whom received supports 24 hour per day. That requires a lot of staff and we are incredibly proud of the staff providing this care. Their dedication to the people they support is amazing.

ROIs' Board of Directors just approved a new, comprehensive strategic plan to guide the organization over the next five years. There are six different business segments to this plan. The external components, those supporting people in the community, are residential supports (group homes and supported living), Homestead Housing Services (affordable housing), Payee Services (managing money for those who cannot do so for themselves), and the Great Lakes Center's autism services (outpatient and intensive treatment). The other components of the plan focus on how various aspects of ROI administrative services can better support the programs that directly impact people's lives. We look forward to implementing this new strategic plan and have already starting work on the first-year goals.

We had another very good year fiscally, and the ROI Board reinvests those funds utilizing a three-pronged approach.

- improving the quality of the buildings that are home for people with disabilities
- sharing ROI's resources with the staff who continue to provide amazing care
- directing funds to help rebuild ROI's cash reserves so our cash flow can assist the organization during any "rocky times."

What drives all of us though is helping people to have a better quality of life, and we are confident we did that again this year - for 592 people with significant disabilities, and their families.

Core Values


- We place the needs of the individuals we serve as our highest priority.

ROI provided residential and support services to individuals, children and families throughout the year in these areas:




28 Individuals with disabilities received assistance in day-to-day needs through our **Specialized Residential licensed group homes.**


18 Individuals with disabilities were able to live as independently as possible in the community through our **Supported Living Alternatives program.**
